PENTATEUCH	BIB-201	An introductory survey of the first five books of the Bible
HOMILETICS I	MIN-155	Explores the art of preaching. Defines expository preaching and gives a systematic process for preparing and preaching an expository sermon based on Biblical structure.
THE BOOK OF ACTS	BIB-208	A detail study of the Book of Acts, the missionary development of the early church; the life and missionary journey of the Apostle Paul.
ELEMENTARY HEBREW	LAG-105	A study of the Semitic language of the Hebrew in its ancient form; the language of the Israelites and their ancestors

RATIONAL PASTORAL THY.	ADM-402	The application of theological truth to all of life and to ministry focusing on preaching, leadership, biblical counseling, evangelism and mission for positive change in relationships with God's people.

HERMENEUTICS	THY-202	The study of the science and laws of Biblical exegesis and interpretation; the principles, methods and rules by which the true meaning of Scripture may be ascertained

CHURCH HISTORY II	HIS-240	An in-depth examination of Christian Church History, Black Church History, Black Theology, and the African American's experience and contribution to the Kingdom of God and the Christian community
SOUND DOCTRINE	THY-306	A study of the teachings of the Father revealed in Jesus Christ and transmitted to mankind by the Holy Spirit.
CHAPEL	BIB-001	ASSIGNED CLASS
